



The third of July is marked as an **International plastic bag-free day**. Plastic Bag Free Day is a global initiative that aims to eliminate the use of single-use plastic bags in the world. Plastic bags were first introduced in 1965. On average, plastic bags are used for 25 minutes, Yet, it takes between 100 to 500 years for a plastic bag to disintegrate (depending on the type of plastic).

International Co-operative Day is an annual celebration of co-operative movement observed on the first Saturday in July since 1923 by the International Co-operative Alliance. This year, the International Day of Cooperatives is celebrated on 3^{rd} July 2021 as "Rebuild better together".



Northeast Greenland National Park is the world's largest national park and the 9th largest protected area. It was established in 1974. A large area that covers and protects 972,001 sq. km. of the interior and northeastern coast of Greenland.

In any case, if it is not approved by the Parliament within six weeks, the ordinance comes to an end.






