# Academic Day :23rd April 2016

On the occasion of Academic Day, every year, as is well known, it is a usual practice to take stock of the academic year that has gone by-reflect on good practices as well as areas that needed improvement so that we prepare ourselves for the forthcoming academic year.

Coming to Scholastic Areas of the School, we have adhered to the CBSE norms for CCE practices. Formative Assessments were conducted along with On Going assessments .Parents were called on Open Days to discuss their wards' performances. Teachers used the CBSE Ongoing Assessment patterns of CCE to design innovative Individual products and group products as well as teaching and learning activities.

Promotion norms were followed after SA2. Classes 10 and 12 appeared for the CBSE Board Exams wherein adequate revision was given prior to the Board exams. External paper setting and evaluation was arranged for Class 12 - Physics, Chemistry and Maths that guided the teachers as well as the students.

The curriculum included new areas of exploration like Madhubani painintg and Coffee powder paining-thereby giving exposure to traditional art as well as innovative forms of painting

ICT: The school has a tie up with NIIT to provide latest software and curriculum in ICT and to enhance the student's skill in programming, animation and technology.

# SCIENTIFIC SKILLS

BiBox is an innovation tool kit that helps a child build all that the child imagines. It is an Open,Scalable and Fun educational tool in line with the 21st century curriculum which gives a comprehensive, practical exposure to Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts & Maths. The students explored new avenues of scientific thinking and designed new products which were showcased during the National Science Day on February 28<sup>th</sup> 2016.

# SPORTS AND YOGA

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As a part of continuing physical education programme to students, various games are being played during the regular classes. Students are encouraged to participate in inter-house, inter-school, regional /national level competitions.
