The Union List consists of 97 subjects of national importance such as Defence, Railways, Post and Telegraph, etc. The State List consists of 66 subjects of local interest such as Public Health, Police, Local Self Government, etc. The Concurrent List has 47 subjects such as Education, Electricity, Trade Union, Economic and Social planning etc.



The registrar of National Day Calendar has officially designated March 30 as National Virtual Vacation Day that was established by Terrance Talks Travel in 2016, to celebrate the rise of technology that helps to see the world from the comfort zone. #### **Constitutional Values**



Close Relationship between the Legislature and the Executive: In India, there is a close relationship between the executive, i.e, the council of Ministers with the Prime Minister at the head and the legislature, i.e. the Parliament. Only the leader of the majority party or coalition of parties can be appointed as the Prime Minister. All the members of the Council of Ministers must be the Members of Parliament. It is only on the advice of the Council of Ministers that the President can summon and prorogue the sessions of both Houses of Parliament and even dissolve the Lok Sabha.
