POCSO

The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012 was enacted to provide a robust legal framework for the protection of children from offences of sexual assault, sexual harassment and pornography, while safeguarding the interest of the child at every stage of the judicial process. Forms of child sexual abuse include engaging in sexual activities with a child, indecent exposure, child grooming, child sexual exploitation or using a child to produce child pornography. Child sexual abuse can occur mostly in home or school. The effects of child sexual abuse can include depression, post traumatic stress disorder, propensity to further victimization in adulthood and physical injury to the child. To deal with child sexual abuse cases, the Government has brought in a special law, namely, The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012. In order to ensure strict compliance of the POCSO Act, **Sishya School**, Hosur has taken several initiatives and actions for creating awareness about sexual exploitation among the school children.

Grievance Handling

A grievance is any dissatisfaction or feeling of injustice having connection with one's situation which is brought to the attention of management. Grievance Redressal System is a mechanism commonly used to receive and act on grievances reported by stakeholders of private or public institutions, enabling timely actions on any issue raised by them and to avail services more effectively. This grievance administration system enables effective monitoring and submission of status report regarding the number of grievances received and disposed of. This online grievance redress system in School will work to the satisfaction of students, parents and other stakeholders ensuring greater confidentiality and transparency in grievance dealing procedure.
